

SUPPLIER PASSWORD RESET

STEP-BY-STEP QUICK TUTORIAL - ETENDERING FOR HATTON NATIONAL BANK


Access the HNB eTendering portal using <https://etendering.hnb.lk>.

The portal works best on the latest browser versions of Firefox and Chrome.

1. STEP 1: CLICK FORGOT PASSWORD
2. STEP 2: ENTER EMAIL ADDRESS
3. STEP 3: CHECK YOUR EMAIL INBOX
4. STEP 4: PASSWORD RESET PAGE
5. STEP 5: PASSWORD TOO WEAK
6. STEP 6: CLICK RESET


STEP 1: CLICK FORGOT PASSWORD

- a. Go to the eTendering portal Sign in page.
- b. Click on "Forgot Password".




STEP 2: ENTER EMAIL ADDRESS

- c. From step 01, you will be directed to the "Forgot Password" page
- d. Use this screen to enter the registered email address, to reset the password.
- e. Click on the "Submit" button




STEP 3: CHECK YOUR EMAIL INBOX

- f. You will now receive an email to the registered and entered email account inbox. Please check spam/trash if not received.
- g. Click on the "Proceed" button to continue the reset process.




STEP 4: PASSWORD RESET PAGE

- h. The link will re-direct you to a web page with option to enter the new password.
- i. Enter the “New Password” and same “Confirm Password” to reset.





STEP 5: PASSWORD TOO WEAK


- j. If the password is highlighted in red as “Too Weak”, it will not get submitted.
- k. Please enter a password with,
- ✓ at least one capital letter
 - ✓ at least one simple letter
 - ✓ at least one number
 - ✓ at least one special character @ # \$ % & !



STEP 6: CLICK RESET

- l. Please enter a password with,
- ✓ at least one capital letter
 - ✓ at least one simple letter
 - ✓ at least one number
 - ✓ at least one special character @ # \$ % & !
- m. If the password is highlighted in green as “Strong”, it will be accepted.
- n. Once both passwords are identically entered and marked in green, click on “Reset”. The success message will then appear on your window.
